

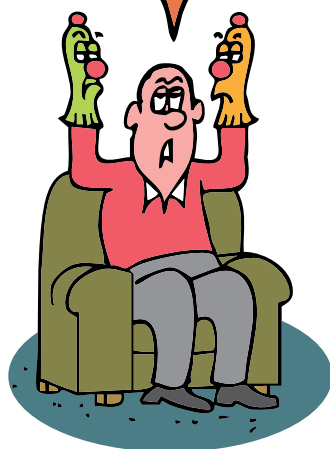

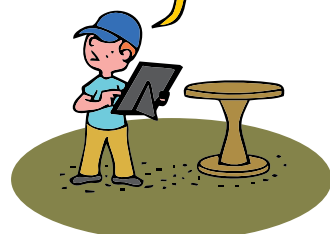

What do you call mail that's been left out in the sun too long? Toastal service.

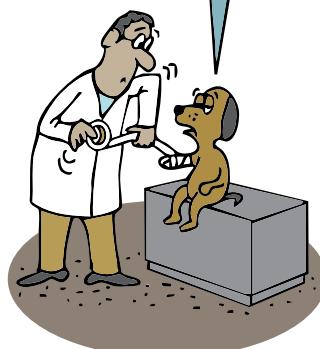
Changed all my passwords to Kenny. Now I have all Kenny Loggins.
