Mary: "What do you miss most?"

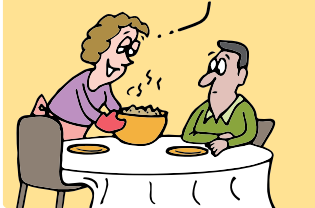
Tom: "The last train home at night."
