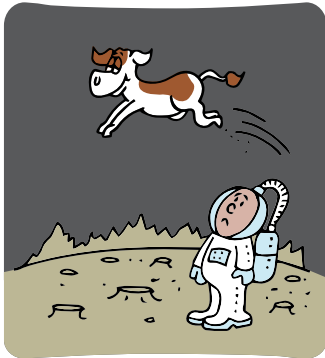

A sweater is a garment worn by a child when his mother feels chilly.

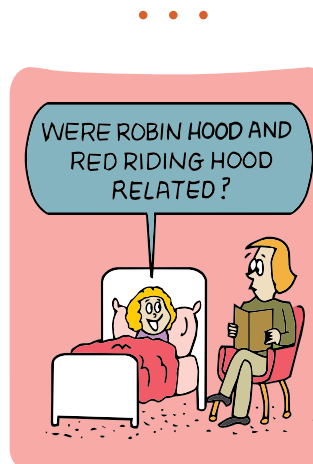
I used to be a banker ... but I lost interest.
